

About this way of life, hear what our Lord says:

From the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female. 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one. So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate.

St. Mark 10: 6-9

Marriage is therefore not by any to be undertaken lightly or ill-advisedly, but seriously and prayerfully, duly considering the purposes for which it is ordained.

It is ordained:

- That marriage gives full expression to the love between man and woman; that in marriage husband and wife belong to each other, and with affection and tenderness freely give themselves to each other:
- That in marriage husband and wife may give to each other life-long companionship, help, and comfort, both in prosperity and in adversity;
- ➤ That marriage is the foundation of true family life where God may hallow and direct the natural instincts and affections created by the God and redeemed in Christ;
- That marriage is God's appointed way for the continuance of the human race; that children may be born and brought up in families in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ to the glory of God; in an atmosphere of security and trust.
- That, marriage being thus held in honour, human society may stand upon firm foundations.

Solemn Consent

The Minister says:

here to be united in this holy estate. But if anyone of you here knows any just cause why they may not be married according to the discipline of the Church and the law of this land, please make it known now, or else forever hold your peace.

If no impediment is alleged, the minister says to the persons who are to be married:

models Name and models Name I charge you both in the presence of God and this congregation, that if either of you knows any reason why you may not be joined together in marriage, you do now confess it.

If no impediment is alleged, minister prays:

Almighty and most merciful God, without whose help we cannot do anything as we ought, we pray that, as you have brought these persons together by your providence, you will enrich them with your grace, that they may enter into the marriage covenant as in your sight, and truly keep the vows they are about to make; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

Declaration of intent

Then the minister says to Groom's Name:

<u>Groom's Name</u>, will you have this woman, <u>Bride's Name</u> to be your wife, and cleave to her alone? Will you love her, honour her and be a faithful husband to her as long as you both shall live?

And. Groom's Name answers:

I will, with God's help.

The minister says to Bride's Name:

Bride's Name will you have this man, *Groom's Name* to be your husband, and cleave to him alone? Will you love him, honour him and be a faithful wife to him as long as you both shall live?

And Bride's Name answers:

I will, with God's help.

Sermon

Seventold Blessing

During the singing of the following psalm, the couple moves to the altar.

PSALM: 128

AMEN.

Blessed are all they that fear the Lord; and walk in His ways.

For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands; O well is thee, and happy shalt thou be.

Thy wife shall be as the fruitful vine: upon the walls of thine house.

Thy children like the olive plants: round about the table.

Lo, thus shall the man be blessed: that feareth the Lord.

The Lord from out of Zion shall so bless thee : that thou shalt see Jerusalem in prosperity all thy life long.

Yea, that thou shalt see thy children's children and peace upon Israel.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son; and to the Holy Ghost;

As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be; world without end. Amen.

The Minister says:

Most merciful and gracious God, our Father, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named; send your blessing upon *Groom's Name* and *Bride's Name* whom we bless in your name; that living faithfully together; they may surely perform and keep the vow and covenant between them made, and may ever remain in perfect love and peace together and live according to your law; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

Marriage Blessing

The Minister says:

God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit, bless, preserve and keep you; the Lord mercifully look upon you with favour, and fill you with all spiritual grace; that you may so live together in this life that in the world to come you may have life everlasting. **Amen.**

Choir: Choral Blessing

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace.

A Bible is placed in the hands of the couple.

The minister says:

May the Word of God be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path. Let the Bible help you to recognize whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, and let it show you the path of excellence. The God of peace will be with you.

Affirmation of the families

The Minister says:

The families of both <u>Groom's Name</u> and <u>Bride's Name</u> now come forward, please. They come forward and stand beside the bride and the groom.

The Minister says:

Dear Parents, Do you give your blessing to *Groom's Name and Bride's Name* and promise to do everything in your power to uphold them in their marriage?

The Parents respond:

We give our blessing and promise our loving support.

As <u>Groom's Name</u>stretches out his right hand and keeps his palm open, <u>Groom's Name</u>'s parents will hold his right hand

Then <u>Bride's Name</u>'s parents places her right hand on the right hand of <u>Groom's Name</u> who will receive the right hand of <u>Bride's Name</u> and hold it.

One of the parents prays for the couple.

Affirmation of the congregation

The Minister addresses the congregation:

Will all of you witnessing these vows, do everything in your power to uphold **Groom's Name** and **Bride's Name** in their marriage?

The congregation answers:

We will, with God's help

The marriage pledge

The couple faces each other and Groom's Name Says after the minister:

Before God and these witnesses, I, <u>Groom's Name</u> take you, <u>Bride's Name</u> to be my wife, to have and to hold from this day forward; for better, for worse; for richer, for poorer; in health and in sickness; to love, cherish, and protect, as long as we both shall live, according to God's holy law; and to this I give you my pledge.

They continue to hold their hands and <u>Bride's Name</u> says after the minister:

Before God and these witnesses, I, Bride's Name take you, Groom's Name to be my husband, to have and to hold from this day forward; for better, for worse; for richer, for poorer; in health and in sickness; to love, cherish, and protect, as long as we both shall live, according to God's holy law; and to this I give you my pledge.

The minister says:

God has heard your vows, and we are witnesses.

Hymn (sing prayerfully)

O perfect Love, all human thought transcending, Lowly we kneel in prayer before Thy throne, That theirs may be the love which knows no ending, Whom Thou for ever more dost join in one

O perfect Life, be Thou their full assurance Of tender charity and steadfast faith, Of patient hope and quiet brave endurance With child like trust that fears neither pain nor death,

Grant them the joy which brightens earthly sorrow; Grant them the peace which calms all earthly strife, And to life's day the glorious unknown morrow, That dawns upon eternal love and life.

Blessing of the Thirumangalyam and the Rings

The minister says:

Bless this Thirumangalyam and these Rings, O merciful Lord, that *Groom's Name* and *Bride's Name* who will give and wear them all through their lives may ever be faithful one to the other, and continue together in love so long as they both shall live; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. **Amen**

I request the congregation to stand now.

Groom's Name lifts up the facial veil of .Bride's Name ...

Then the minister delivers the Thirumangalyam to <u>Groom's Name</u> who puts it on <u>Bride's Name</u> in the customary manner.

Then the couple faces each other and Groom's Name holding the Thirumangalyam, says after the minister:

Bride's Name this Thirumangalyam I give you as a sign of our constant faith and abiding love, I honour you with all that I am, and with all that I have, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Bride's Name says after the minister:

Groom's Name this Thirumangalyam I accept and shall wear it as a token of constant faith and abiding love, I honour you with all that I am, and with all that I have, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen. (If Rings are used)

The Minister gives the ring to Groom's Name

Groom's Nameplaces the ring on **Bride's Name**'s left ring finger and says:

Bride's I give you this ring as a symbol of my love, and with this ring I marry you.

Bride's Name then places the ring on Groom's Name's left ring finger says: Groom's Name I give you this ring as a symbol of my love, and with this ring I marry you.

Declaration of Marriage

The Minster Declares:

Whom therefore God has joined together, let no one separate.

Then Groom's Name and Bride's Name kneel, while the congregation stands.
